By God's grace, our baby twins are growing well and are even beginning to sleep long stretches throughout the night, which is a tremendous blessing. Their passports have also been applied for, processed, and mailed back to us already. As far as paperwork is concerned, this was the first step we needed to take to move our family to Sweden. Now we have to apply for visas; but this cannot happen until our sponsor church in Sweden is legally recognized. Our friends in Sweden are working on the necessary documents required to submit the application for a non-profit. They are hoping to have this submitted by the end of November. This means that we should hopefully be able to apply for visas in the early part of December. Please continue to pray with us that all of these things would come to pass in a timely manner and that our move to Sweden could come without delay.









At the end of October, I (Don) was privileged to travel to Wichita, Kansas to participate in a church's missions conference. This conference was very unique because the pastor is of Swedish heritage. Pastor Larry Olson of the Heritage Baptist Church not only has Swedish roots, but served there as a missionary for over five years. It was a blessed experience to get to know him and glean as much as I could from his experience in Sweden and ministry in general. Riding on the back of one of his horses was also a first-time experience for me!

Please pray for our baby daughter Caelyn. She has a respiratory issue called laryngomalacia. It is actually a fairly common issue found in infants. Some babies have it worse than others. Caelyn only has a mild form, and will eventually outgrow it, but it is still concerning. She has had a couple episodes that were pretty scary. Pray with us that she would outgrow this issue sooner than later and that her breathing would never be hindered by it.
