For us, the start of 2019 has come and gone in what seems like no time. *Concerning our daughter, Caelyn, she has recovered very well from her surgery and is doing much better as a result of it. As of the writing of this letter, our visa applications have been officially submitted to the Swedish migration board, or *migrationsverket*. Clicking the last button and submitting the final page of the application was a surreal moment. We have not been given any timeframe as to if and when our application will be approved and processed. Nevertheless, we are confident that we have supplied all the necessary information. *Please pray with us that the migration board would find no reason to delay our entrance into the country and that we would be granted a work permit conducive to life and ministry in Sweden.* Ideally, we are hoping to be granted a work visa that will permit us a minimum of two years in country, after which we can apply for an extension, or renewal.

Until our visas are approved, we will continue serving the Lord where we're at and preparing to minister abroad. Coming up, I will have some opportunities to preach, including a missions conference in which I have been asked to speak on grace giving. Please pray the Lord would use me to edify and encourage His people through the truth of God's Word.
